Adverb

An Adverb is a word that describes a verb, adjective, or another adverb in any sentence.

Example:

The girl runs **quickly**.
The bird is **very** small.
The students always study **so** quietly.

Diagram labels:

- Verb: points to runs
- Adjective: points to small
- Adverb: points to **so**

Types of Adverbs

Adverb of Manner - They describes how someone does something or how something happens.

Adverb of Time - tells us when an action happened, and also how long and how often.

Adverb of Place - tells about the location where the action of verb being carried out.
