## **Tenses of the Verb**

Three basic forms of verbs are past, present and future.

The past tense refers to an action that was already done.

The present tense is for present action.

The future tense is for an action that will be done.

#### Example

- 1) I <u>lived</u> in KSA. (Past Tense)
- 2) I <u>live</u> in KSA. (Present Tense)
- 3) I <u>will live</u> in KSA. (Future Tense)
