

Prepositions

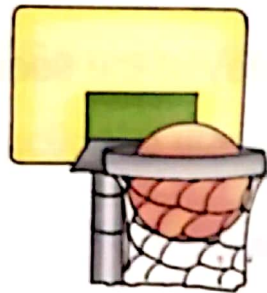
A preposition is a word that tells us where a person or thing is in a sentence.



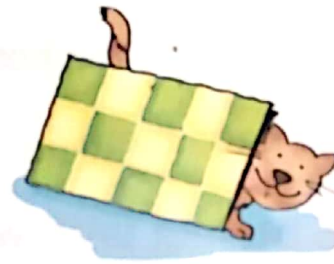
