### “THE LION AND THE BEAR”

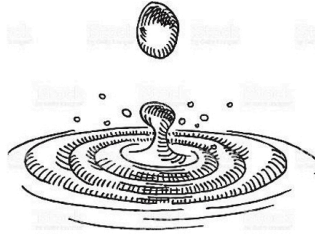
It was a hot summer day.

They began arguing and fighting about who should drink first. After a while, they got tired and stopped for a breath, where they noticed





vultures above.
