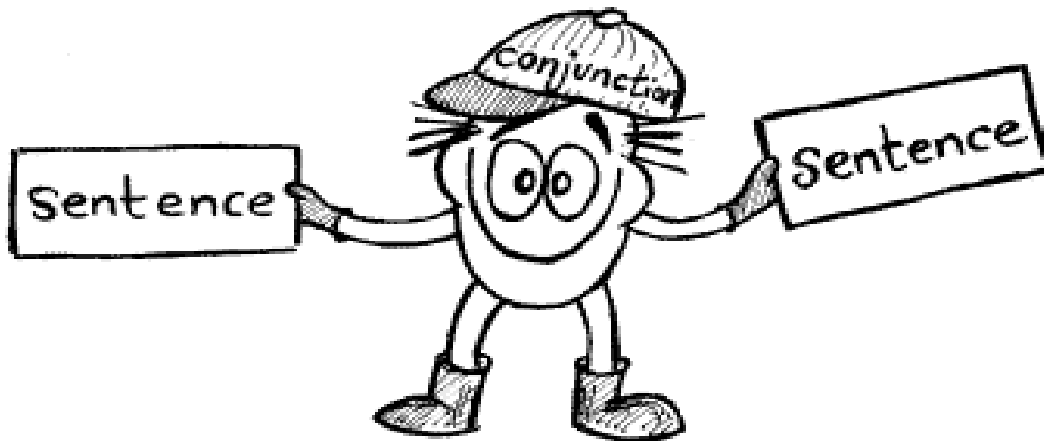


Definition of Conjunction

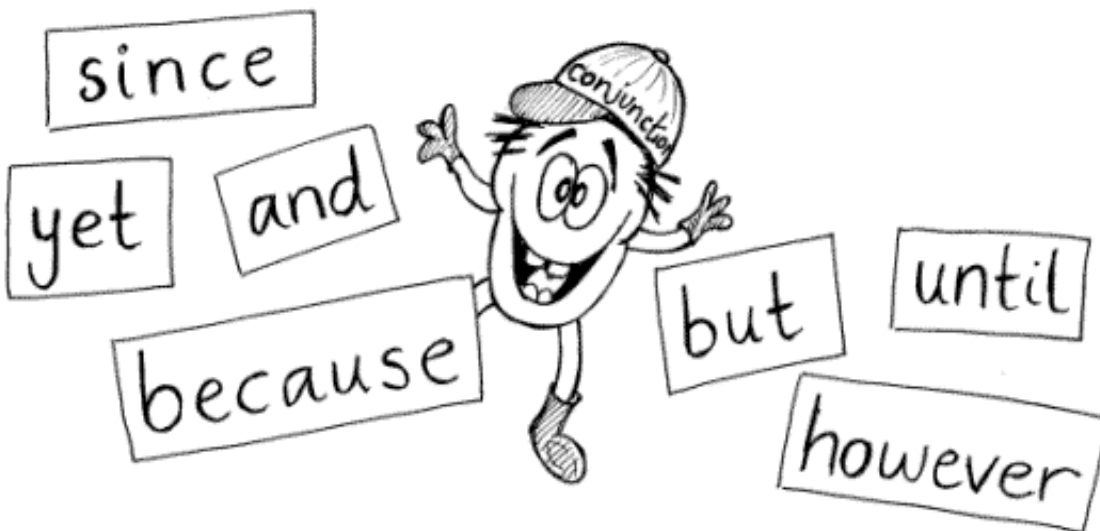
A Conjunction is a part of speech that connects two words, sentence phrases or clauses.



Examples:

1. I ate pizza and pasta

2. I like reading but I don't like drawing
