A preposition is a word used to link nouns, pronouns, or phrases to other words within a sentence. They act to connect the people, objects, time and locations of a sentence.

Example:-

- The book is (on the table)
- Peter jumped (into the river)
- Laila lives (across the road)
- We have a surprise (for you)

These **nouns** or **pronouns** are called the **OBJECTS** of the **prepositions**.

- The book is (on the table)
- The frog jumped (into the river)
