A <u>preposition</u> is a word used to link nouns, pronouns, or phrases to other words within a sentence. They act to connect the people, objects, time and locations of a sentence. <u>Example:-</u>

- The book is (<u>on</u> the <u>table</u>)
- Peter jumped (into the river)
- Laila lives (<u>across</u> the <u>road</u>)
- We have a surprise (<u>for you</u>)

These nouns or pronouns are called the **OBJECTS** of the prepositions.

- The book is (<u>on</u> the <u>table</u>)
- The frog jumped (into the river)
