A <u>preposition</u> is a word used to link nouns, pronouns, or phrases to other words within a sentence. They act to connect the people, objects, time and locations of a sentence.

#### **Example:-**

- The book is (on the table)
- Peter jumped (<u>into</u> the <u>river</u>)
- Laila lives (across the road)
- We have a surprise (<u>for you</u>)

These nouns or pronouns are called the OBJECTS of the prepositions.

- The book is (on the table)
- The frog jumped (into the river)
