Following programs will be conducted:


- 1. Video on Water Day

Following are the details of the competition for each level:

Level 1, 2 & 3: Create a decorative chart about your usage of water

<u>for a day</u>. (decoration should be related to Water Day theme) This will help the students to understand the importance of water by developing awareness of their own daily consumption.

Level 4 to 7: <u>Present a meaningful photograph of your own or from the</u> <u>internet related to the theme "valuing water"</u> and speak based on the photograph for 2 minute. (sample photo given)



Level 8 & 9: <u>**Table Topic competition**</u>. The students will present the topic related to water day given to them on the spot and will speak impromptu for 2 minutes. (The speech should be presented with a proper beginning, body and conclusion.)
